Bill Sterling, "Reasonable Doubt"

Best known for his fan-favorite role of Tommy on the Starz smash hit "Power," Joseph Sikora was also the series lead of its spinoff series, "Force." He had a three-season arc opposite Jason Bateman on the critically acclaimed series "Ozark" for Netflix and appeared in features including "The Intruder" for Sony/Screen Gems and "Jacob's Ladder" for director David M. Rosenthal. Some of Sikora's previous work includes recurring roles on "Maniac" (Netflix), "True Detective" (HBO) and the Paramount/Skydance feature "Jack Reacher," in which he had a pivotal role opposite Tom Cruise. On stage, Sikora first gained notoriety for his work in "Chicago," prior to appearing in numerous productions on and off Broadway in New York. He was also the recipient of the Ovation Award for his work in the West Coast premiere of Tracy Letts' "Killer Joe." He is a proud member of SAG-AFTRA and the DGA. Sikora is a partner in Black Fox Productions, which looks to create TV storylines inspired in part by his native Chicago.
